COVID LIMITATIONS

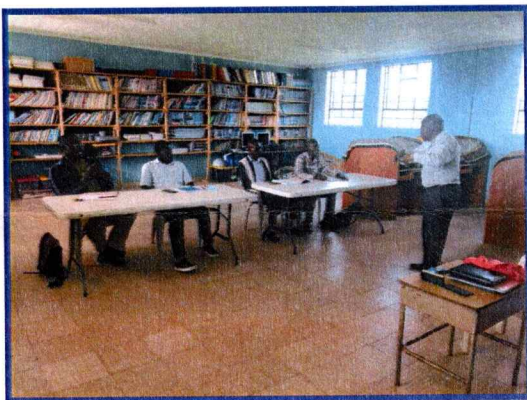
We still have some limitations on the ministry due to Covid restrictions, although slowly, we have begun implementing some things again. This past week, we had our first Bible college session in over a year and a half. We plan to begin our soul-winning program again in November, and I also have a tentative trip planned to visit our churches in Burundi. Unfortunately, we are still not able to get back into the Congo due to the restrictions.

KOSGEI FAMILY

The Kosgei family moved to Northern Kenya near the Kakuma refugee camps and the border of South Sudan in July. They have settled nicely into the area and have begun making contacts in the camp, setting up preaching points, and working towards seeing a church started in the near future. They have already seen several salvation decisions and have begun discipling converts. Wendy and I took a trip to visit them last month and were greatly encouraged. The potential to reach many needy, neglected people groups from this area is great. We have begun planning to open a satellite branch of our Bible college in this area as it is too far and too expensive to have people travel to Nakuru to receive training.

SWAHILI BIBLE TRANSLATION

We had an excellent translation conference that introduced the translation project to churches and pastors. Around 100 pastors, missionaries, and church representatives came as we explained what we were doing, how we are doing it, and why a new translation was needed. The reception was outstanding, and many volunteered to be part of it. The translation building is near completion, with just a few minor finishing work to be done. At the beginning of September, the four men who will be working daily on the translation began their training. They are in full-time Swahili language school until the end of this year. Although they are native Swahili speakers, we thought it was needed for them to better understand proper Swahili grammar, sentence structure, etc. Would you please keep this project in your daily prayers?
