It looks as though the owner will allow us to continue a month by month until we find a new location, but we can't be there much longer. We've only had one option so far, and not all of the people are in agreement with it. **Please continue to pray for the Lord's direction and open doors in this area.** We've had a few special offerings come in to help in the mean-time and we really do appreciate your concern and generosity!
